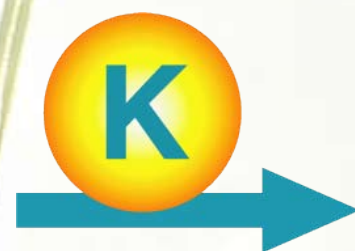

What is Fainal-K?

Fainal-K is a potassium-rich liquid solution, suitable for foliar spraying to correct potassium deficiencies and promote grain fill in broadacre crops.

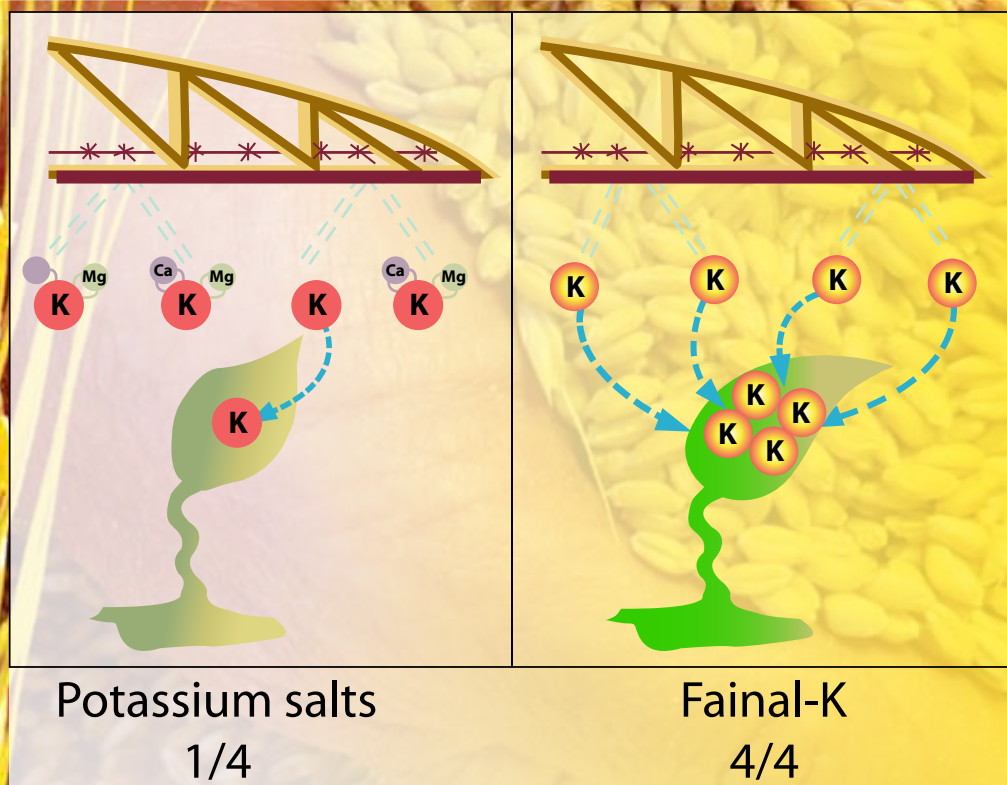

How does Fainal-K work?

Fainal-K is a highly effective, high concentration potassium fertilizer. It is a 100% soluble liquid solution. Fainal-K delivers a concentrated dose of the essential nutrient potassium

Fainal-K has the exact content of nitrogen to balance a possible stop of the vegetative growth, with total nitrogen availability to the plant leaves.

Fainal-K contains a special blocking agent to neutralize the antagonistic effects of Ca and Mg ions in spray water. This increases the availability and absorption of potassium resulting in more efficient uptake

Fainal-K has been shown to improve grain fill and crop yields in a range of wheat and barley cultivars

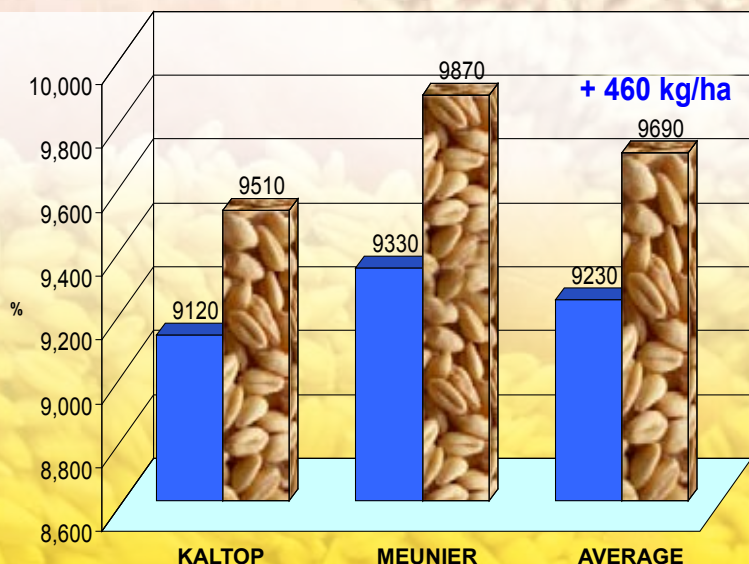

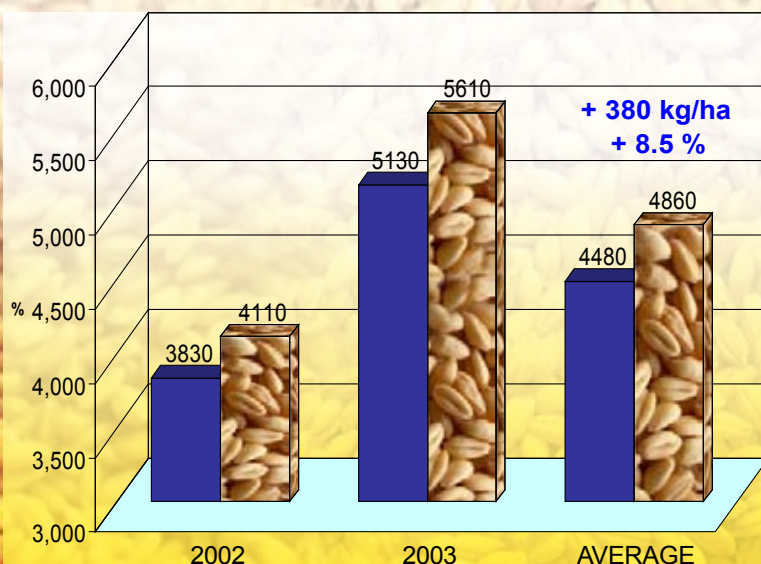

Fainal-K applied at 2 L/ha at ear emergence

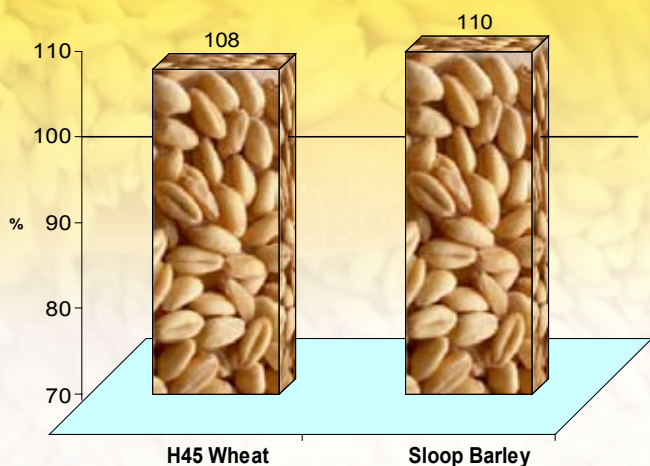
2002 & 2003 Lithuania, Malting Barley var.

Fainal-K applications at the end of crop cycles, increases yield and grain size

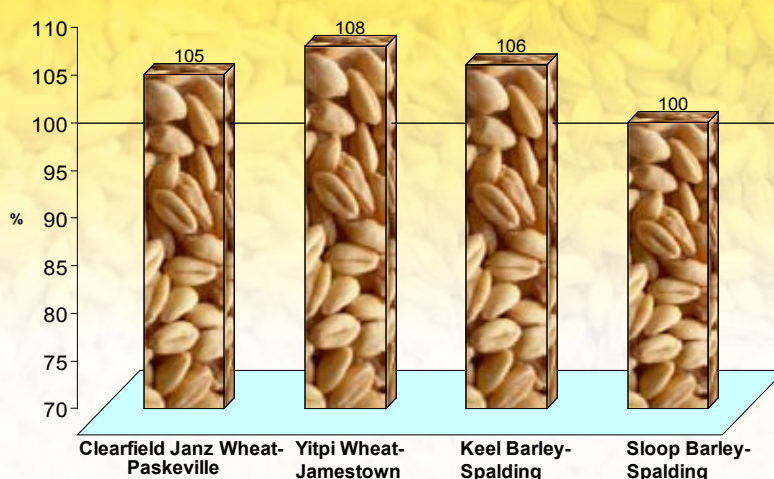
Fainal-K Trial in Cereals, Paskeville, 2004

NOTE: SCREENINGS HAVE BEEN REDUCED IN ALL TRIALS. ON AVERAGE, BARLEY SCREENINGS ARE REDUCED BY 10.6% AND WHEAT SCREENINGS ARE REDUCED BY 6.33%

General Applications

Fainal-K is 100% soluble and mixes readily. Fainal-K can be tank mixed with most commonly used insecticides and fungicides. For further information contact Agspec, your local agronomist or conduct a small test in a container before use.

Crop	Rate	Timing and Comments
Wheat and Barley	2 L/ha	Apply just prior to or at flag leaf emergence (Z39)
Canola	2 L/ha	Applied prior to or at bolting
Grain Legumes	2 L/ha	Apply prior to flowering
Pastures	2 – 4 L/ha	Apply after each grazing or cutting for hay

Return on Investment Summary

The table below details the return on investment from an application of Fainal-K of 2L/ha at Z39. The application costs have been ignored as the application can be applied in conjunction with a fungicide.

The application of Fainal-K has consistently increased yield over untreated, while also providing a positive return on investment for the grower over 3 years.
